



## 2019 Parish Retreat September 28 and 29

Whether you are new to the Little Trinity community or have been coming for years, you don't want to miss this year's parish retreat at YMCA Geneva Park. This is your opportunity to connect deeper with the community of Little T and to deepen our connection with Jesus Christ, who binds us all together. Our rector, Tim Haughton, will guide us in our interactive sessions and fellowship together, using the theme "Go On Loving One Another." Children and youth programming run concurrently.

### **What to Expect:**

YMCA Geneva Park is just over 1.5 hours from Toronto, near Orillia, ON. Light refreshments are provided upon arrival starting at 9 am on Saturday, September 28. The first session begins at 10 am. (Note: We are not guaranteed to get into our rooms until 4 pm, although some rooms are ready after the first session ends at noon). Saturday afternoon is devoted to having fun and building community together, including sports activities, arts and crafts, nature walks, board games, or a session on a spiritual discipline. After our dinner, Saturday evening activities include board games, a compline service, and a large group activity (TBA!). Sunday morning's session includes a family communion service, and then our retreat ends after lunch on Sunday.

### **How to Register:**

- Register online at [www.littletrinity.org/events](http://www.littletrinity.org/events) or in person starting after the September 8 morning service.
- Prices per person (see below) include one night's accommodation, four meals plus snacks, access to the beautiful grounds, and use of facilities.
- Payment may be made by cheque (payable to Little Trinity Church), online (a processing fee will apply), or by e-transfer ([giving@littletrinity.org](mailto:giving@littletrinity.org)).
- Discounted pricing is available until September 15th only. Prices increase by \$10-20 per person afterwards.
- The adult rate is based on double occupancy; if you are coming on your own and would like to share a room, please try to find a roommate before registering to ensure that you get the double occupancy rate. We will try to match up individuals who would like to have a roommate but we cannot guarantee that

everyone will have a roommate. Single occupancy rooms are available but at a slightly higher rate.

- Triniteens can stay together (2-3 per room) but please register as a family unit and room allocations will be made later.
