

Parking at Little Trinity Church

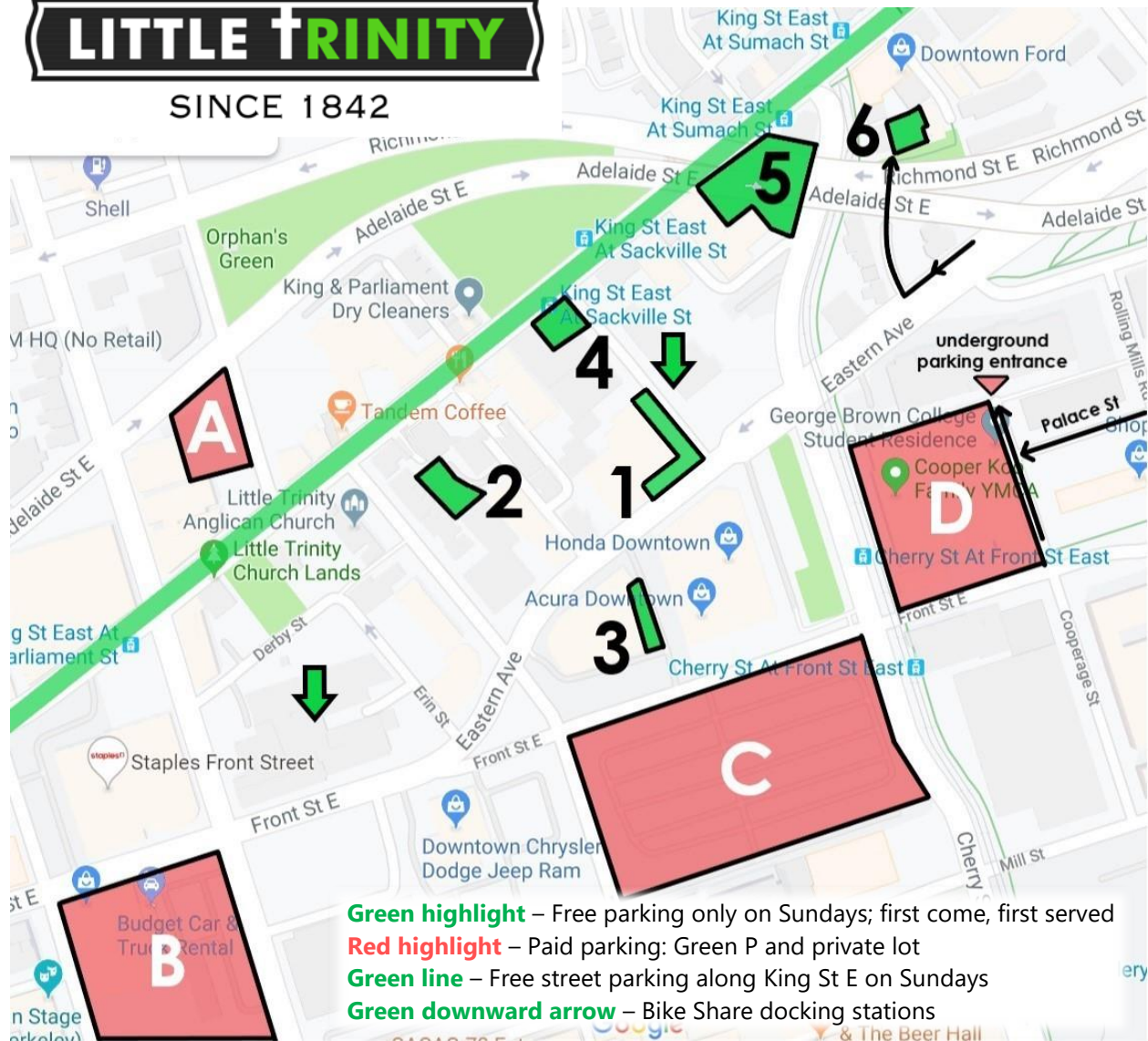
When we had the two Easter Sunday morning services earlier this year, many in our parish community have found it difficult finding parking between services. We are well aware that parking will be a limiting resource as we transition to two Sunday morning services. We would certainly encourage anyone who is able to use public transit, to use rideshare, to walk or cycle to get to the church building.

But for those of us who plan to drive to church, we had canvassed the area around the church building earlier this summer and asked businesses that are closed on Sundays if they would graciously offer their parking space, free of charge, to our parishioners. We had also located nearby paid parking options in the area.

The map below shows the area around Little Trinity Church, highlighting areas of interest related to parking: free parking on Sundays, paid parking on Sundays, Bike Share docking stations, and other information related to transportation into Little Trinity Church.

1. *Assured Automotive* (Eastern Ave & Sackville St) staff and customer parking: **12 spots***
 2. *Multibusiness* parking along Gilead Pl: **10 spots***; **no parking on Fresh Home & Garden**
 3. *Volvo Dealership* customer parking: **14 spots***
 4. *Thruway Muffler & Cam's Auto Service* parking: **20 spots***
 5. *Bay Cat and Dog Hospital* (King St E & Sumach St) private lot: **30 spots***
 6. *Ford Dealership* customer parking: **10 spots*** – **entry/exit via Eastern Ave. one way**
- A. Paid private parking: **40 spots*** (\$5.00 Sundays from 6AM-6PM)
 - B. Green P public parking: **80 spots*** (\$2.50/30min. \$14.00 max 7AM-6PM)
 - C. Green P public parking: **170 spots*** (\$2.00/30min. \$12.00 max for 4 hours)
 - D. Green P underground public parking: (\$3.00/hour) entry via Palace St. or Cooperage St.

* Number of spots are estimates when lot is empty; available parking space not guaranteed

Via TTC

- **Coming from Subway Line 1 Yonge/University/Spadina:** The 504 King Streetcar travels along King Street between Dundas West Station in the west and Broadview Station in the east, connecting with Subway Line 1 at both King and St. Andrew Stations. Disembark the streetcar at Parliament Street; the church building is half a block east from Parliament Street. Please refer to a downloadable transit mobile app for up-to-date public transit schedules and route changes.
- **Coming from Subway Line 2 Bloor/Danforth:** The 65 Parliament Bus route operates between Castle Frank Station on the Bloor-Danforth Subway and the area of The Esplanade and Princess Street, generally in a north-south direction. Disembark the bus at Parliament Street; the church building is half a block east from Parliament Street. Please refer to a downloadable transit mobile app for up-to-date public transit schedules and route changes.

Via car/highway

- **Coming from west-side via Gardiner Expressway:**
 - Exit via Jarvis St. ramp towards Lake Shore Blvd. E
 - Continue eastbound via Lake Shore Blvd. E
 - Turn left onto Parliament St.
 - Continue northbound via Parliament St.
 - Turn right onto King St. (Destination will be on the right)
- **Coming from north-side via 404/Don Valley Parkway:**
 - Exit via Richmond St. ramp.
 - Merge onto Eastern Ave.
 - Use the middle lane to continue onto Richmond St. E
 - Turn left at the first cross street onto Power St.
 - Turn left onto King St. (Destination will be on the right)
- **Coming from east-side via Eastern Avenue:**
 - Continue westbound via Eastern Ave.
 - Use the middle lane to continue onto Richmond St. E
 - Turn left at the first cross street onto Power St.
 - Turn left onto King St. (Destination will be on the right)
