OPPORTUNITY

We are seeking a part-time COORDINATOR, VOLUNTEER & CREATIVE [Salaried role averaging 20hrs a week]]

Start date to be negotiated (Sooner the better but no later than Sept 1st 2022). The role will be a one-year contract position at which point the role will be re-evaluated.

There would be the expectation that the candidate would regularly be present for Sunday post-service connection times in order to build the relationships necessary to discern gifts and fit for ministry opportunities.

The hope for this role is that as our church returns to the full congregational life there is the need to re-engage together in gospel ministry, and help newcomers find the fullness of a spiritual home through exercising their God-given gifts.

QUALIFICATIONS

- An active and vibrant walk with Jesus and commitment to the communal life of the church.
- An able, creative, articulate, and competent communicator in various forms and settings.
- Proven track record in discerning, training, and encouraging volunteer leaders.
- Organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Proven ability to work with a diverse team of people toward a common goal.
- Basic proficiency in database management and word processing.



ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES

This role is responsible to perform a range of duties including by not limited to:

Volunteer Engagement (55%)

- Assess the spiritual and practical gifts of the congregation and maintain a database for easy access of ministry leads. (Children, Youth, Alpha, Small Groups, Clusters etc.)
- Engage newcomers to the community in ways that they might participate in the full life of the church.
- Facilitate a gift discernment and learning process
- Work with Ministry Leaders to support the recruitment, training, retention, encouragement, and thanking of volunteers.
- Regularly assess the health of the volunteers to support ministry leaders in the care of their team.
- Develop and manage a centralized volunteer recruitment process (Ministry Fair, Text to Serve etc.)
- Work with the Parish Administrator to ensure compliance with Diocesan Screening in Faith and assist in scheduling.

Creative Engagement (30%)



- Coordinate the artistic gifts of the congregation in support of our worship and service.
- Utilizing the diverse artistic gifts of the congregation foster spaces where spiritual engagement can occur.
- Support existing ministries with creative input.

Administrative Support of overall ministry (15%)

- Provide coverage for parish administrator in their absence.
- Develop and curate the social media presence of Little Trinity Church in accordance with our social media policy.
- Work with the staff team to develop and deliver a parish directory.
- Attend and engage in weekly staff meetings [Tuesday 11:30am –
 1:30pm]
