- 1. What troubles and disturbs us as a culture and as citizens in Toronto?
- 2. When King Nebuchadnezzar was disturbed, he abused his power to feel in control again. When his council of advisors were disturbed, they were helpless. When Daniel and his friends were disturbed, they turned to God for mercy. How do we as a society and as Christians in Toronto respond whenever we are "disturbed"?
- 3. In Daniel's doxology, he praised God for His sovereign control and wisdom over all things. How does this reality transform our Christian lives in Toronto?
- 4. How can we as Christians speak prophetically and bear witness to the Gospel in a world that is constantly being disturbed?
