4. The sermon referred to the bestiality of human kingdoms—what injustices are on your heart right now? How do you engage/deal with them? Where do you see God's judgment in these situations?
5. How would it change our day to day situation if we thought about the world as always ending rather than about the end of the world as a future event: that is, if we thought about the present as the future in the process of becoming?
6. How did you feel about the suggestion that one way to make it through the pandemic was by praying? Did that feel real—or just pious? Do you/have you ever had a rhythm of prayer? How does it affect you?
