- 4. The sermon referred to the bestiality of human kingdoms—what injustices are on your heart right now? How do you engage/deal with them? Where do you see God's judgment in these situations?
- 5. How would it change our day to day situation if we thought about the world as always ending rather than about the end of the world as a future event: that is, if we thought about the present as the future in the process of becoming?
- 6. How did you feel about the suggestion that one way to make it through the pandemic was by praying? Did that feel real—or just pious? Do you/have you ever had a rhythm of prayer? How does it affect you?
