Read Luke 24:13-35

1. What are some of the popular narratives or storylines "out there" that lift and carry us as individuals and as a society like the tidal waves and undercurrents of the ocean?
2. How does the Great Story of Scripture, the Narrative of Christ's Gospel, confront, conflict, and correspond with the cultural and personal narratives of our age?
3. Consider your own personal narrative and storyline as related to the Christian faith: where along the journey do you feel the risen Jesus has run up beside you and is encouraging you to stop, be still, and consider His presence?
4. How could we encourage one another to "walk back" or to journey back into "Jerusalem", into the places of darkness and injustice in our lives and society, to proclaim good news?
