Position: 6-9 month contract with the possibility of an extension.

Time Commitment: 8-10 hours/wk inclusive of Sunday services from 7:30 AM-12:30 PM and Thursday rehearsals for 2-3 hours.

Opportunity Overview

The Sound Technician Coordinator is responsible for providing oversight to the sound ministry through training, engaging and inspiring volunteers to fully and capably serve our community.

Skills

- Proven experience as a sound technician or audio engineer.
- Knowledge and ability to operate Behringer X32 Digital Sound Board or equivalent.
- Knowledge and ability to operate streaming and projection software, i.e. OBS and Proclaim.
- Technical ability in setting up and operating soundboards, microphones, amplifiers, audio lines, monitors, speakers, video cameras, Windows computers, basic computer networking and basic software troubleshooting.
- Good aural and critical listening skills to assess audio quality.
- Ability to work well under pressure and meet deadlines.
- · Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Leadership skills for directing a team of volunteers.
- Experience working in a church environment is an asset.



Key Responsibilities

Sound and Video Requirements

Create a distraction-free worship atmosphere.

- Set up and teardown equipment.
- Perform sound checks and mix sound during service.
- Ensure stream and recording are functioning properly.
- Ensure sound for video content and slides pertinent to service is set up.
- Provide parishioners with hearing-assisted devices as needed.
- Identify and replace faulty equipment.
- Provide technical support as needed to the Lyric Projection ministry.
- Check with worship leaders and church administration for service needs.
- Anticipate the needs of worship leaders and church administration for service.

Training and Team Building

Train volunteer technicians to be proficient on new technology purchased during the pandemic.

- Retrain technicians on new sound equipment.
- Recruit and train new volunteers to create a robust team.
- Educate technicians on proper stage and equipment set up, teardown, maintenance and storage of equipment.
- Create and maintain volunteer schedule with scheduling software.
- Provide additional training opportunities at Thursday rehearsal.
- Create milestones that allow volunteers to grow in their capabilities.
- During training, provide uninterrupted coverage of all technical roles during services.
- Ensure technical changes are communicated to both AM and PM volunteers to ensure consistency and quality between services.

Rehearsal and Special Services

Provide support to worship team rehearsal and liturgical services.

Thursday Rehearsal

- Arrive ahead of worship to set up for worship team.
- Provide sound support for rehearsal.
- Provide opportunity for additional training to technicians.
- Clear stage as required in anticipation of Sunday.



Special Services

 Provide appropriate coverage of all technical roles for liturgical services outside of Sunday worship, i.e., Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Blue Christmas, Prayer & Praise and other assigned services.
