“To Whom Shall We God?” John 6:52-71

Read John 6: 52-71

1. When Jesus said “I am the bread of life” what was the significance of the use of the words “I am”? What was he hinting at?
2. Many disciples turned back from following Jesus in response to Jesus’ claims to divinity. What kind of things in our own lives tempt us to turn back from following Jesus?
3. What did James suggest Jesus was all about? And what was the important difference between the two Greek words for life: *bios* and *zoe*?
4. How does one participate in the *zoe* life, the eternal life of God? Read John 3: 1-16.
5. What have we learned about life in community, especially the sacramental part of that life, during the pandemic lock-downs? James suggested one thing, but this is an open question: what have **you** learned?
6. What is the glorious reality that sustains our *zoe* life even when we can’t participate in communion?
