

## **Nov 21/21 – Small Group Questions**

### **Read Colossians 2:9-12, 3:1-10**

1. Paul said that given the Incarnation of God becoming human, we have been filled in Jesus (i.e. we have been fulfilled, completed, or finalised in Jesus). What did Paul mean by that?
2. Baptism unites us to Jesus in a mysterious and spiritual bond. If we have been so united to Jesus in His life, death, resurrection, ascension, and session in heaven, how does that impact our present lives today?
3. Since we have been raised with Jesus in heaven through baptism/union, Paul exhorts us to seek the things that are above. What did Paul mean by that and what are specific examples of our "seeking things above"?
4. Since we have also died with Jesus on the cross through baptism/union, Paul exhorts us to put to death what is earthly in us (i.e. carnal). What did Paul mean by that and what are specific examples of our "putting to death what is earthly"?
