The psalm is King David's prayer for his son and successor, Solomon. The psalm eventually became a prayer over the Israelite kings during their coronation. In the psalm, David prays for six things for the king of Israel: endowed righteousness, endless rule, expansive rule, social justice, and prosperity.

1. How are Christians endowed with justice and righteousness?
2. How do Christians now participate in the endless and expansive rule of Jesus?
3. How can Christians embody gospel-centred social justice?
4. How can Christian contribute to the true prosperity of society?
