Haggai 2:1-9

1. What do our Gospel reading (John 2:13-22) and our Epistle reading (1 Corinthians 6:12-20) allow us to conclude about the dwelling place of God?
2. Based on these same two passages, every conversation about the dwelling place of God must also be a conversation about what?
3. Holiness is both “from” and “to.” In the sermon James said that “we can abandon all manner of people and things and be no more holy because of it.” According to James, what is holiness an abandonment to? Do you agree?
4. In Haggai 2:4 what kind of strength is the prophet talking about?
5. In the same verse, what was the work the Israelites were to do? If we are the temple of God, what kind of work are we to be doing?
6. What were the two kinds of fears that James talked about (vss 6-7, vs 5)?
7. According to James, what does the treasure of gold, silver & jewels represent?
8. What then is the latter glory?
