2. What did James suggest the essence of sin was?
3. James also suggested that the lists of individual sins served an important purpose. What was that purpose? And why do we need it?
4. James suggested 2 reasons why we often don't take our own sins seriously. What are those reasons? Can you think of any others?
5. What is one of the consequences of not taking our sin seriously when it comes to God's rescue plan?
6. Once we have experienced God's redeeming work in our lives, we have important choices to make. What are the choices mentioned in the sermon?
7. Why does Paul emphasize in vs 27 that with this plan of redemption there is no room for boasting?
