1. Read Isaiah 62 as a group. What resonated with you from the sermon (hearing the scripture)?
2. God renames Zion 'My delight is in her'. In what circumstances (when/where) does this feel true, personally for you?
3. Twice (vs 1,6-7) there are statements about people calling out to God. How do you understand the role of intercessory prayer?
4. In Vs 10, there is a directive to go beyond the boundary of the City and build up the road, removing stones to clear the way for others to come to the City. How might this apply to Little Trinity Church as a community discerning its role in neighborhood engagement?
5. The redemption of the economic system of farming around Jerusalem (vs8-9) is part of God's restoration. What systems in Toronto may need redemption? Are any of these in the sphere of influence of Little Trinity? If so, how? If not, what then?

Bonus Questions: (Not covered in the sermon)

6. Vs 11 is understood by many theologians as referring to Jesus. Assuming that is the case - what might this phrase mean: "Behold His reward is with Him, and His compensation before Him".
