

## **Mar 17 – Leader’s Guide - Luke 7:36-50 - “Christ Our Refuge”**

*The point of the sermon was that this passage is best understood simply by dwelling in it, and so that’s what’s recommended for this study together. It may be best simply to do a ‘lectio divina’ style study, and so this is what these questions will suggest. 1. Begin with prayer. Invite each other to hold one another in Christ’s loving presence.
2. Read the passage slowly out loud together. What words or phrases stand out?

*Invite the group to say one word or phrase, but not to comment on them or unpack them. Ask group members to refrain from commenting on each other’s responses at this time.*

3. Read the passage again. What do you feel? What specific situation in your life today relates to what you hear?

*Invite the group to share one sentence or paragraph about what has been arising for them. Ask group members to refrain from commenting on each other’s responses at this time.*

4. Read the passage a third time. What is Christ’s personal invitation to you in this passage?

*Invite the group to share freely what God has been doing in their hearts through this passage. Spend some time in prayer for each other.*
