READINGS:

Psalm 107:23-30; 35:19-25

Psalm 107:23-30

- ²³ Some went down to the sea in ships, doing business on the great waters;
- ²⁴ they saw the deeds of the Lord, his wondrous works in the deep.
- ²⁵ For he commanded and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves of the sea.
- ²⁶ They mounted up to heaven; they went down to the depths; their courage melted away in their evil plight;
- ²⁷ they reeled and staggered as though drunk and all their wisdom was swallowed up.
- ²⁸ Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.
- ²⁹ He made the storm be still, and the waves of the sea were hushed.
- ³⁰ Then they were glad that the waters were quiet, and he brought them to their desired haven.

Psalm 35:19-25

- ¹⁹ Let not those rejoice over me who are wrongfully my foes,
- and let not those wink the eye
- who hate me without cause.

And he awoke and rebuked the wind and the raging waves, and they ceased, and there was a calm. ²⁵ He said to them, "Where is your faith?" And they were afraid, and they marveled, saying to one another, "Who then is this, that he commands even winds and water, and they obey him?"
