

Small Groups

A small group is a community within a community (typically between 6-12 people) that gathers together anywhere from once a week to once a month to discuss the sermon or study the Bible together. They are meant to encourage deeper relationship with God but also with others, so that together they are growing in Christ and in the context of community. They pray together, study the Word together and work through both good and hard times together.

A small group leader must be mature believers who lead a committed and intentional Christian life. They must have an aptitude for teaching the Bible, learning with others, and handling open discussions and facilitating prayer in a small group setting.

Small group hosts much be generous and hospitable and welcoming to provide a space for many people to gather.
