<u>"Graces Given for the Sake of the World" - Rom 12:1-10</u> (Small Group Questions)

- 1. How do you feel about the topic of spiritual gifts? Are there gifts that make you uneasy or that you aren't sure about?
- 2. The phrase 'spiritual gift' in Greek is 'charisma', or 'grace-gift'. What is the spiritual gift that is free for the taking for anyone who wants it? (Hint: see Romans 6:23)
- 3. Why did the Holy Spirit choose to pour out gifts upon the church?
- 4. Paul mentions spiritual gifts in three main places: 1 Cor 12-14; Ephesians 4; and Romans 12. What are the gifts that he lists? Do you see any overlaps? Anything missing? (E.g. would you consider music or accounting to be a spiritual gift?)
- 5. Are there gifts that you wish you had or feel guilty that you don't have?
- 6. As time permits, spend some time as a group taking turns affirming the gifts you see in each other.
