Read Proverbs 20:6; 12:22, 27:6

- 1. What do we learn about the nature of faithfulness from these passages?
- 2. From your discussion how would you define faithfulness as it relates to our words, our commitments, and our relationships?

Read Mark 14:32-42

- 3. See Isaiah 51:17, Jeremiah 25:15-16; and Ezekiel 23:33. What is the cup Jesus is preparing to drink? What does this mean for him experientially? (both in what you see in the text and from what you can infer)
- 4. Reflect together on the nature of Jesus' faithfulness towards you. Praise him for it!
- 5. Compare Jesus' faithfulness and the disciple's faithlessness. How does he respond to them? What does this tell us about how Jesus responds to our faithlessness?

Read Psalm 42:5-11

- 6. Hear the psalmist's agony in reflecting on the cost of faithfulness oriented toward the faithfulness of God in prayer. How would such a prayerful orientation shape faithfulness in us?
- 7. How can beholding the faithfulness of Jesus towards us lead us to face the cost of being faithful?
