- 3. What are the two things that are a necessary preparation for running the race (vs. 1)? Why are they both necessary to point out?
- 4. Where should we be looking as we run the race (vs. 2)? Why?
- 5. What is the nature of our race course (vs. 2)? Read Mark 8:34-37.
- 6. Why do you think these words about the cross don't land with the same force as they would have when they were first spoken/written?
- 7. How is the self-sacrificing path of Christian discipleship different from the various idolatries of the world (James mentioned 2 key things in the sermon)?
- 8. What is the purpose of having the character of Jesus (the fruit of the Spirit) more fully formed within us?
- 9. For reflection: What are your thoughts/feelings about the death of the self-centered you?
