

Oct 12/25 - David: A Man After God's Own Heart

Small Group Questions.

Bruce has suggested, based on Psalm 31, that David lived with three core convictions:

- God is Able
- God Sees
- God is Trustworthy.

1. Has there been a time (or times) in your life when you have found it particularly challenging to hold one or more of these convictions? Talk with the group about your experience with these challenges if you feel comfortable doing so.
2. Bruce suggested that there are three aspects to David's trust in God:
 - a. I trust your Timing.
 - b. I trust your Grace.
 - c. I trust your Mercy.

Can you share a time when you were challenged to trust God in one of these areas?

3. In explaining the meaning of the Parable of the Sower to his disciples (Luke 8:9-15), Jesus identified the "thorns" that choke out spiritual life as "the cares and riches and pleasures of life." Discuss how the cares and riches and pleasures of life can keep us from having an "undivided heart" (Psalm 86:11, NIV).
