Discussion Questions

- 1. The sermon described Acts 4 as giving us a "picture of kingdom living" rather than an impossible ideal or political blueprint. What part of that picture stood out to you most, and why?**
- 2. Jesus tells his followers, "Fear not, little flock." What are some of the fears or anxieties that make it difficult for us to live with the freedom and generosity described in Acts 4?**
- 3. The sermon suggested that the word *mine* loses its power in God's kingdom. Where do you find it hardest to loosen your grip on what feels like "mine"?**
- 4. Acts says that "great grace was upon them all." How is that different from simply trying harder to be generous or kind?**
- 5. The sermon described the Church as giving the world a foretaste of God's coming kingdom. Where have you experienced a glimpse of that kind of community?**
- 6. (Optional) Barnabas was remembered as a "Son of Encouragement." If you were to give your fellow small group members 'kingdom-shaped nicknames', what would they be?**
